What Every Visitor Wants To Know!

We want your visit to the Grove to be as pleasant as possible. With that in mind, we have assembled this list of questions that our guests most frequently ask.

When should I arrive?

We suggest arriving 10 or so minutes before the meeting begins. You will be greeted as you arrive at the hall. As well as being welcomed we'll be able to explain how things work, and where to go and sort out a cuppa for you. After the afternoon meeting we usually stay on for a chat and refreshments.

Where do I go when I get there?

The main entrance leads into the foyer where the toilets (inc. disabled facilities) are on your left. The Hall is through the double doors to the right. Those from the church are generally available up to 20 minutes before the meeting starts to assist you.

What to wear?

Though we take worship seriously the atmosphere at the church is relaxed. People are friendly and there is no dress code. We hope that you would feel equally comfortable whether you wear a tie or a T-shirt.

During the Meeting

In our meetings (which are usually about an hour long), we:

- Honour the Lord Jesus Christ in our actions and our worship
- Build one another up by singing hymns and Christian songs
- Read the Bible together
- Pray to God together
- Have a talk and song for the Children
- Have a talk explaining the message of the Bible (usually 25-30mins) with colouring/quiz activities for younger children
- In our afternoon meetings we take a collection for the work of the church.
