of the Meeting of Occold Parish Council held at 8pm on Wednesday 23rd August 2017 at The Beeches

The meeting had been called to discuss a planning application

1. Apologies and Declarations of Interest

Apologies had been received from Mr Flack and Mr Hubner
Mr Hull did not attend as he has a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest with regard to the planning application, being the landowner

2. Planning Application DC/17/02791: Retention of permanent siting of poultry shed for the housing of free range poultry

The application related to the poultry sheds on land to the west of the B1077. These had initially been erected with permission as mobile units, and planning permission had been obtained for the vehicle access created. The applicant was now applying for retrospective planning permission for the sheds to be retained as a permanent structure following advice from the planning enforcement officer that they were not considered temporary in nature. Councillors discussed the application and voted in favour of supporting it.
